

DISCOVER MICHIGAN 2012

Six destinations have been selected again for the 2012 riding season. You'll need to take a picture of you with your bike at each destination. When you have completed all six, turn them in with your name, address, and phone number. You will then be entered into a drawing held at the membership meeting in November. You'll have all summer to do this. Prizes are as follows: 1st \$200, 2nd \$100, 3rd \$50, 4th \$50, and will be awarded as gift certificates at this time (no need to be present for the drawing). Complete all six and you qualify for all prize places. If you complete only five, you will be in all drawings except for the first place prize. Please note: a rider's passenger (if they are a Tri-County Michigan HOG member) also qualifies for the drawings, so get their picture too.

If you participate in the Teddy Bear Run from Great Lakes Harley-Davidson, or attend the State HOG Rally in Kalamazoo, you can use it as a substitute for ONE of the six selected destinations. Take your picture with something in the background to show that you participated. Check at the dealership for ride dates.

SEA GULL KIDS SLIDE: City of Tawas City Gateway Park, just north of bridge on south side of Tawas.

LARGE BEAR on front of "THE BEAR COMPANY STORE": City of Traverse City

LARGE YELLOW DINOSAUR: Kampvilla RV Park on US 31, about 9 miles south of the town of Benzonia and north of Bear Lake

LARGE BLACK AND WHITE COW: Downtown Elsie

Near-by address: 118 W. Main St, Elsie, MI 48831

Note: If you ride about ¾ miles west of the cow, you will come to a concrete bridge. Look to the right (north) and you will see one of the last remaining iron bridges left in the state. This will be a BONUS PICTURE LOCATION. Go back towards town and you will see a drive that goes to the bridge and the damn next to it. The parking isn't much, it looks like a place where kids go to party. Do not go on the bridge deck, it is unsafe.

TWO BEARS: In front of the only bar in downtown Trout Lake, Upper Peninsula, on road #123
